

Upcoming Reporting Transitions for 2027

CRISP is rolling out updates to quality measure submission and reporting platforms for Maryland's AHEAD Primary Care Programs participants for in 2027.

Data Accuracy Validation Engine (DAVE)

Description:

For PY 2026 Electronic Clinical Quality Measure (eCQM) reporting, practices will transition to the Data Accuracy Validation Engine (DAVE). DAVE is a centralized tool for submitting and calculating eCQM results across all primary care programs, including MDPCP-AHEAD, Primary Care AHEAD (PC AHEAD), and the Medicaid Advanced Primary Care Program. This tool will be available through the CRISP Reporting Services (CRS) portal. Practices will submit patient-level files directly exported from their EHR, either a Clinical Care Document (CCD) or Quality Reporting Document Architecture Category I (QRDA-I) file. These files enable the DAVE tool to calculate measure results across primary care program participation, creating a single solution for quality reporting.

Timeline:

Submissions into DAVE will begin for PY2026 eCQM reporting in **January 2027**. The reporting window is expected to open in January 2027.

Multi-Payer Reporting Suite (MPR) Migration

Description:

Currently, MDPCP-AHEAD and PC AHEAD participants use the MDPCP/PC AHEAD Reporting Suite while Medicaid Advanced Primary Care Program participants use the Multi-Payer Reporting Suite (MPR) for utilization tracking. Starting February 2027, MPR will serve as the single reporting platform for utilization tracking across all of Maryland's AHEAD Primary Care Programs, removing the need to switch between platforms. Program attribution for MDPCP-AHEAD and PC AHEAD and assignment for the Medicaid Advanced Primary Care Program will be pre-loaded into MPR, reducing users' administrative burden. MPR will continue to be available through the CRS portal. While many MDPCP/PC AHEAD reports already align with MPR, not all are included. Practice user feedback sessions will be conducted to identify which reports from the MDPCP/PC AHEAD Reporting Suite participants feel best support their practices in achieving program requirements.

Timeline:

MPR opens to all Primary Care Programs in **February 2027** for 2027 Q1 attribution and assignment. The MDPCP/PC AHEAD Reporting Suite will remain available until July 2027 to access historical data.
