# Overview of the Multi-Payer Reporting Suite

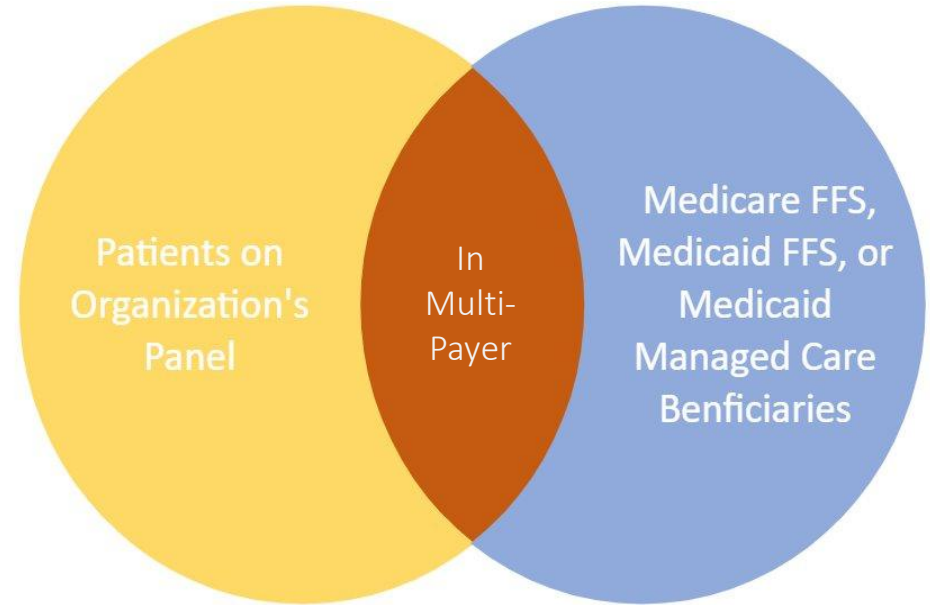
- CRISP, in partnership with hMetrix, created the Multi-payer Reporting Suite to support alignment between Maryland Medicaid and the Maryland Primary Care Program (MDPCP)
- The suite of reports helps users understand trends in hospital utilization, facilitate care coordination, and monitor population health across their Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries
- CRS users with assigned patient panels:
  - Physician practices (MDPCP, PC AHEAD, Medicaid Path, and non-MDPCP)
  - MCO users
  - Hospital users
  - Other CRISP participants that submit panels, including care coordination groups

# Multi-Payer Reporting Suite Data Sources

- The suite displays the following data for patients on an organization's panel:
  - Medicare fee-for-service
  - Medicaid fee-for-service
  - Medicaid Managed Care
- The data includes all care settings and services covered under Medicare and Medicaid
- Data displayed are for the last 36 months and there is a two-month data lag

# Multi-Payer Reporting Suite and Panels

- The Multi-Payer Reporting Suite displays **patients on an organization's panel** who are also enrolled in Medicare FFS, Medicaid FFS, or Medicaid Managed Care
  - Patients not enrolled in Medicare or Medicaid will not appear in the suite
  - Patients not on the organization's panel will not appear in the suite



# Medicaid Advanced PCP and Multi-Payer



Medicaid Advanced PCP participating organizations can download their Managed Care Organization (MCO) Assignment Lists using the CRISP Reporting Services Portal



Organizations can use these lists to complete patient outreach and upload them in a CRISP CEND Panel to view their patients' health data



Medicaid Advanced PCP participating organizations can view claims data for their Medicaid enrollees using the Multi-Payer Reporting Suite

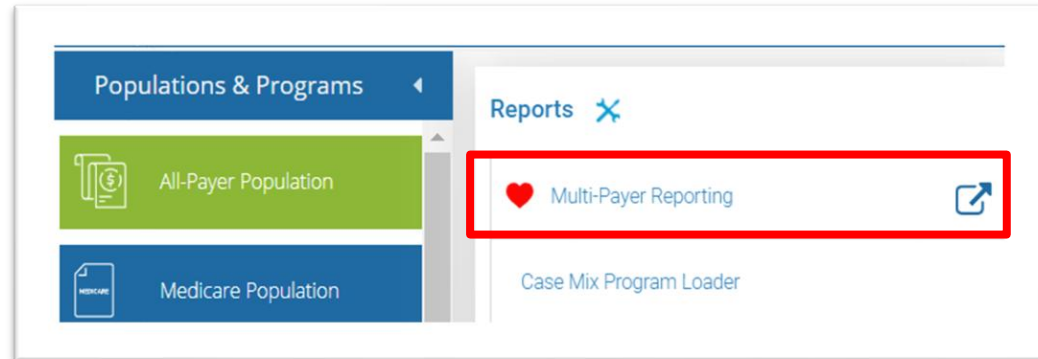
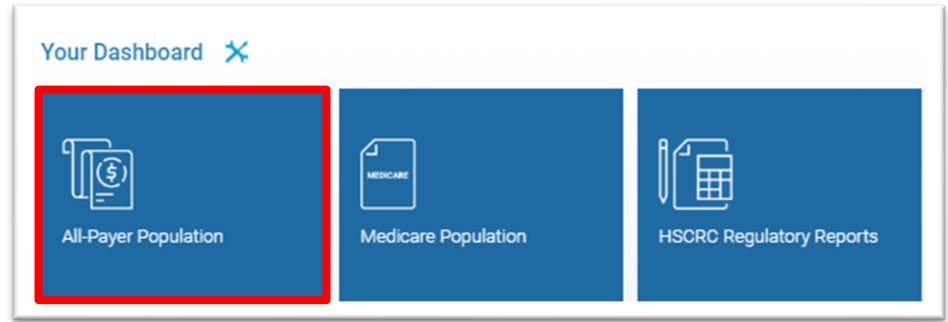
# Downloading the MCO Assignment List

- The List can be submitted to CRISP to generate a panel available in the Multi-Payer Reporting Suite

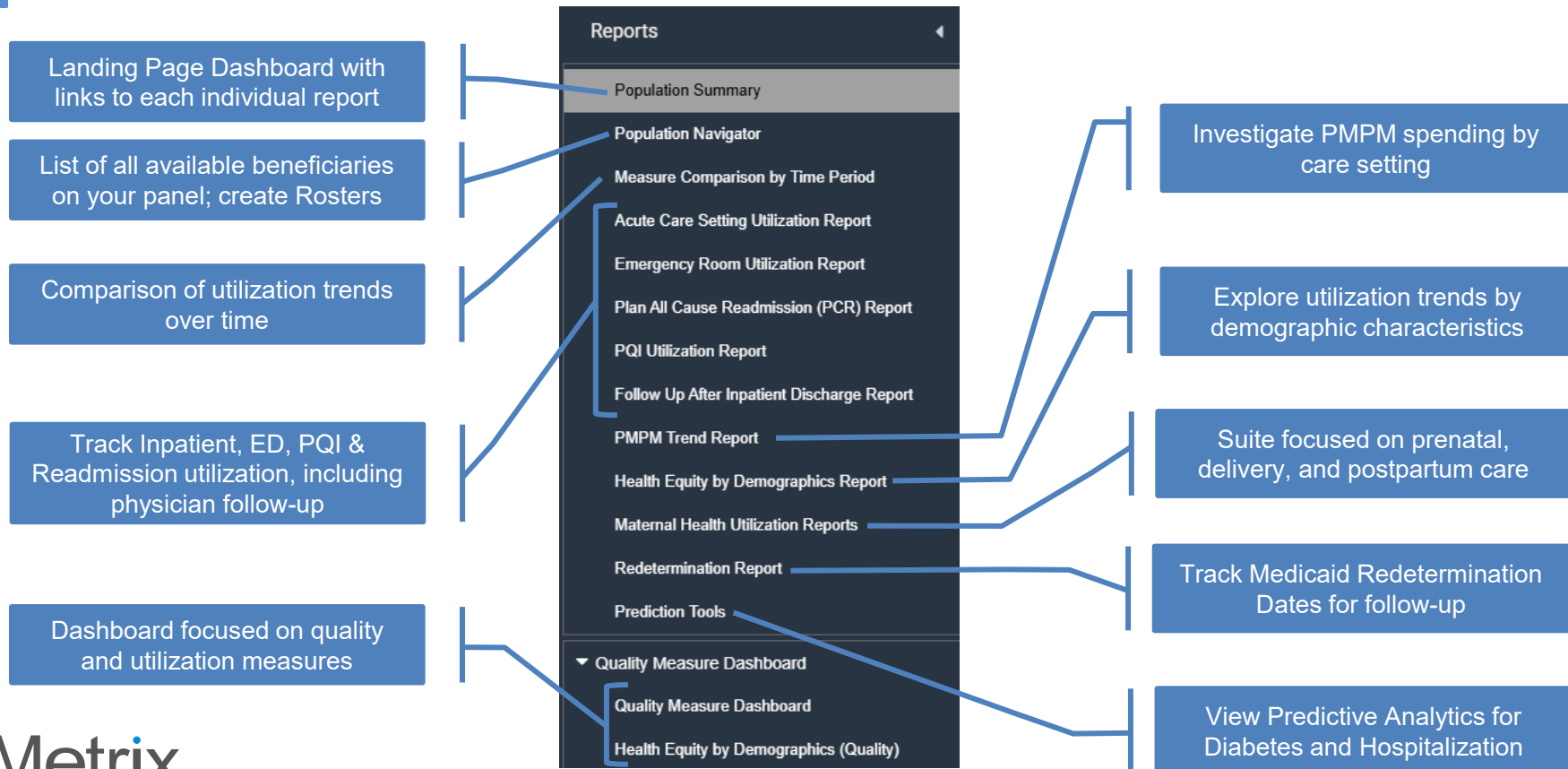
