CRISP is a regional Health Information Exchange (HIE) serving Maryland, the District of Columbia and affiliated with WVHIN, the West Virginia HIE. An HIE is the technology that supports the flow of health information among ambulatory practices, hospitals, labs, radiology centers, and other health care organizations. HIE allows delivery of the right health information to the right place at the right time, providing safer, more timely, efficient, patient-centered care.

What is the Clinical Query Portal?

The Clinical Query Portal is a free tool available to treating providers and their staff. For example, if you are a primary care provider and your patient was admitted to a hospital in the CRISP service area, you could use the portal to look up his/her radiology report and discharge summary.

How does the Portal work?

As clinical information is created and shared with CRISP, it is made accessible in real time to participating health care providers through the Clinical Query Portal. Providers have the ability to securely look up patient information

through the Internet. The portal retrieves the clinical data from participants and displays it in a view-only screen at the point of care. It also facilitates access to patient data across institutional boundaries and provides users:

- Access to real-time clinical information from all CRISP participants, including:
 - Lab results
 - Radiology reports
 - Discharge summaries
 - History and physicals
 - Consultations
 - Operative notes
 - Images
 - Immunizations
 - Transfer summaries
- Access to the RxHub Pharmacy network for medication fill history information
- Access to the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Data
- Access the Patient Care Management Overview and view patient care programs and risk scores.





Who contributes health information?

All acute-care hospitals in Maryland and the District of Columbia hospitals have agreed to share data with CRISP. To see which of these hospitals are currently providing clinical information, please visit www.crisphealth.org, and click on the Participating Providers link. CRISP also receives data from all major lab and radiology centers.

Do I need an EHR to participate?

No. The Clinical Query Portal is available through the Internet. All you need is a computer with an internet connection.

How much does it cost?

The Clinical Query Portal is currently free to providers.
