Administrative and Enrollment Updates



EQIP Enrollment Process



September 2022

- EQIP Entities finalize their episode and intervention selection
- EQIP Entities may split or combine with others if their Care Partners were included in vetting to CMS

October 2022

- CMS Vetting Results are available in EEP
- Care Partner Arrangements Distributed

November – December 2022

 EQIP Entities follow-up with their Care Partners to ensure Arrangement signature

December 31st, 2022

- All Care Partners who signed their Arrangement will be determined 'enrolled'
- Care Partners who do not sign their Arrangements are removed from EQIP Entities for Performance

September 2nd, 2022

 Deadline for Submission of Care Partners in EEP for CMS vetting



Enrollment Update for Performance Year Two

Enrollment as of November 18th:

- 3,558 Care Partners*
- Representation from 43 specialties
- 68 EQIP Entities
- Participation in all 45 available EQIP Entities
- *Final participation will not be determined until 1/1/23

Through the end of 2022, the HSCRC and CRISP will work with participants to:

- Finalize CMS vetting status and eligibility
- Complete contracting and payment operations with UMMC



November - December 2022 Enrollment Activities


- Results from initial CMS vetting was posted in EEP
 - 25 Care Partners did not pass vetting and are not permitted to participate in PY2
 - Program Integrity and Law Enforcement CMS vetting results will be returned late 2022, impact should be small
- Care Partner Arrangements distributed 11/10
 - Lead Care Partners and Administrative Proxies received a link to access the SharePoint folder created for your Entity. You will be able to download all Care Partner Agreement PDFs for your entity.
 - LCPs and APs are responsible for disseminating the Agreements, obtaining signatures of the individual Care Providers, and sending back signed copies prior to Dec 31st
 - Signed copies must be sent to <u>EQIP@umm.edu</u>
 - Only new providers and those who changed entities, are required to sign a CPA for PY2.
 PY1 Providers who remain with the same entity do not need to re-sign, their participation is automatically renewed

Renewal of Care Partner Arrangements

- Renewal of the Care Partner Agreements (CPA) is automatic for subsequent measurement periods, including the next period.
- To ensure the listed providers are registered under the correct entity, we are asking you to confirm in the '<u>EEP Care Partner Dashboard</u>' that the providers registered under your EQIP entity are still participating.
- If a Care Partner is no longer enrolled with your EQIP entity or if a
 Care Partner wishes to terminate participation for PY2, email
 EQIP@crisphealth.org prior to December 31st.

Care Partner Arrangement Status

- Log into EEP, navigate to your Care Partner Dashboard and reference the column "Care Partner Arrangement Status"
- "Signed" indicates the Care Partners that have an existing CPA on file
- Those with no CPA on record (blank) will need to sign to participate in PY2.
- Dashboard will be updated weekly to reflect newly executed CPAs

PY1 Performance Data

1st Quarter Data Availability

- The EQIP portal has been updated to include data on episodes ending in the first quarter of 2022.
 - This allows participants to see how they are performing on the initial tranche of EQIP episodes.
 - We encourage participants not to over interpret the results that are based on relatively small sample sizes.
- Participants can view the performance data through the EQIP Portal.






The Place of Service Report breaks down the average cost of each episode based on the Trigger place of service and the first setting post-trigger.






The Sequence of Care Report shows settings of care that episodes fall into.





The Post-Trigger Hospitalization Summary shows the number of episodes that have a hospitalization post-trigger.










This page shows the number of Potentially Avoidable Episode Complications.







Additional Episode Development

- We welcome ideas from other stakeholders. In order to develop an episode, stakeholders will need to identify:
 - A list of triggering procedures or diagnosis
 - Included and excluded costs for the episode
- The HSCRC is committed to working with all interested stakeholders, but we have limited bandwidth.
 - We anticipate adding 1-2 new episodes per year
 - We will prioritize based on the number of interested physicians



Potential New Episodes

We have been discussing adding the following episodes:

- Additional Prometheus episodes
 - Acute CHF / Pulmonary Edema
 - Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease
 - Deep Vein Thrombosis / Pulmonary Embolism
 - Pneumonia
 - Sepsis
 - Oncology Episodes
- Chronic Kidney Disease / ESRD
- Behavioral Health Episodes

We would be happy to discuss additional episodes. But we need to begin discussions prior to the end of the year.
