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# Background



# Why Use the CRISP InContext Service?

- A practitioner, physician, care coordinator, or etc. may need to access clinical information for a patient which is not present in their EHR or internal patient records.
  - A patient new to a practice or roster is a great example where access to additional external clinical data is valuable
- The CRISP InContext combines data and views in Features that are useful and valuable to clinical users
- The CRISP InContext may be referred to as HIE InContext or the Clinical Information Service



# CRISP InContext Data Sources

- **ADTs** – HL7 messages sent to CRISP when a patient is admitted to a care setting, transferred to another care setting, or discharged from a care setting.
- **CCDs** - stands for Continuity of Care Document, which is an electronically generated, patient-specific clinical summary document used to improve communication between healthcare providers during a transition of care
- **Claims** - A medical claim is a bill that healthcare providers submit to a patient's insurance provider. CRISP has access to MD Medicare, MD Medicaid, and Hospital All Payer

- As a EHR user, when I view a patient's EMR and I click on the CRISP icon in my system, I automatically launch into the CRISP InContext App with the selected patient
- The InContext App launches within the host EHR – size may vary depending on the vendor you are using.
