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# PDMP Interstate Sharing

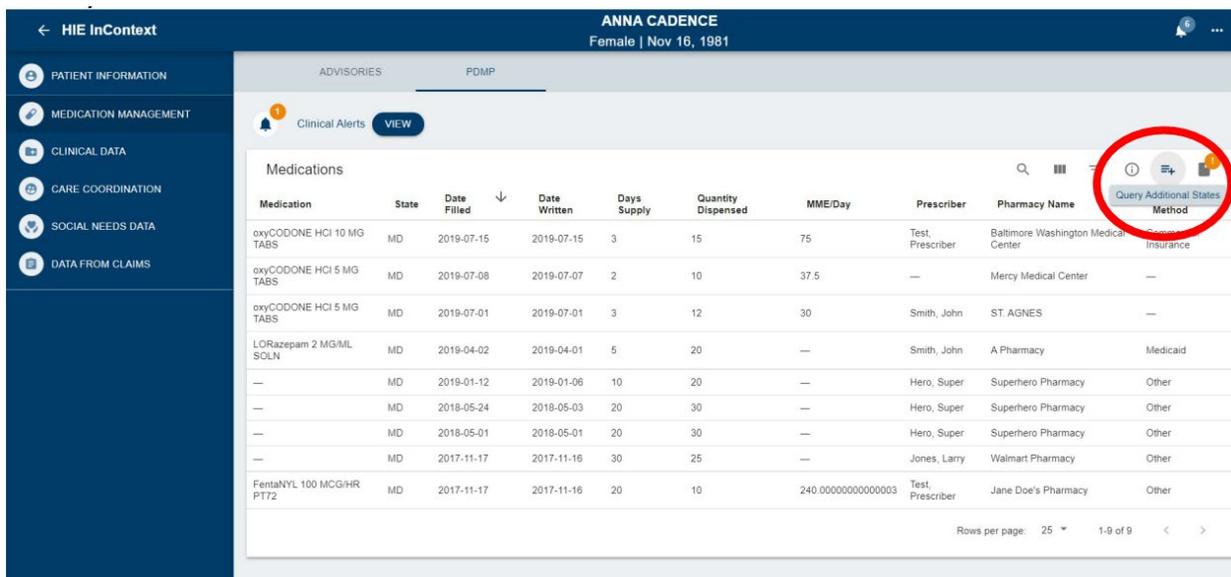
Maryland PDMP participates in interstate data sharing for clinical users with all border states: D.C., Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and West Virginia. Additional connected states include Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Iowa, Kentucky, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Washington, and Wisconsin. Maryland is also connected to Military Health Systems, which provides data from the US Department of Defense’s Defense Health Agency.

Please note that the regulations for disclosure are determined by each state based on the user’s job role, and some types of users may not be authorized to view interstate data.

The Maryland Department of Health is actively working with other states to establish the mutual exchange of prescription drug monitoring program data. Please be advised that out of state prescriptions are matched on last name, first name, and date of birth only, which could result in improper matching in some cases. CRISP encourages providers to use discretion when interpreting interstate data.

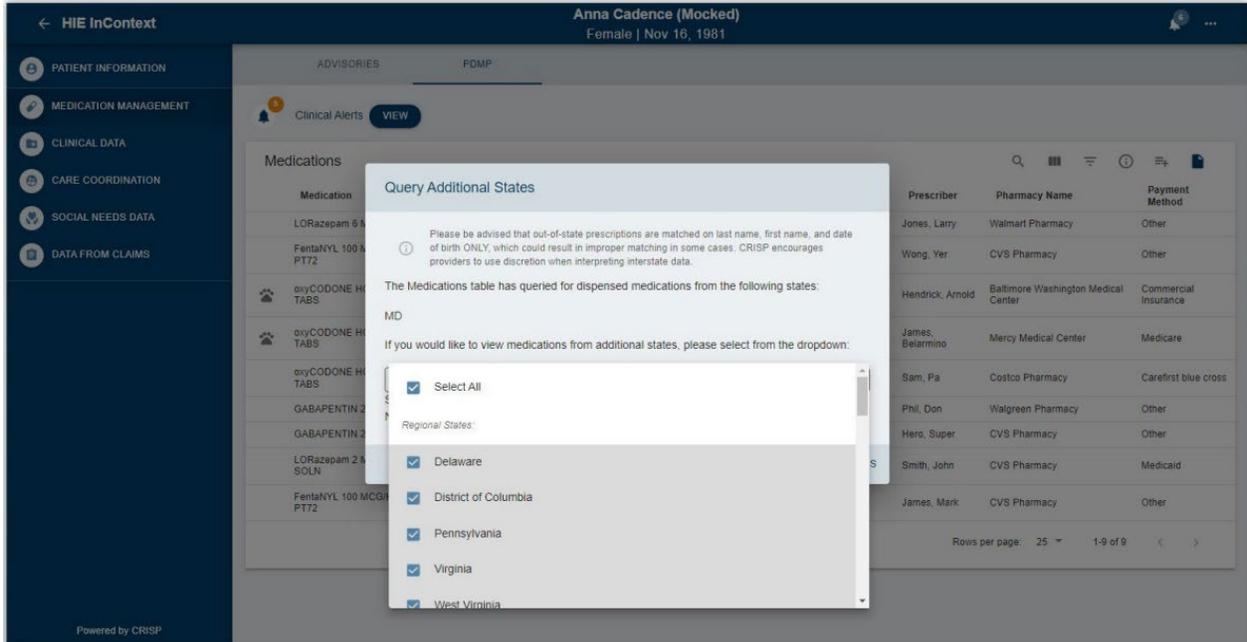

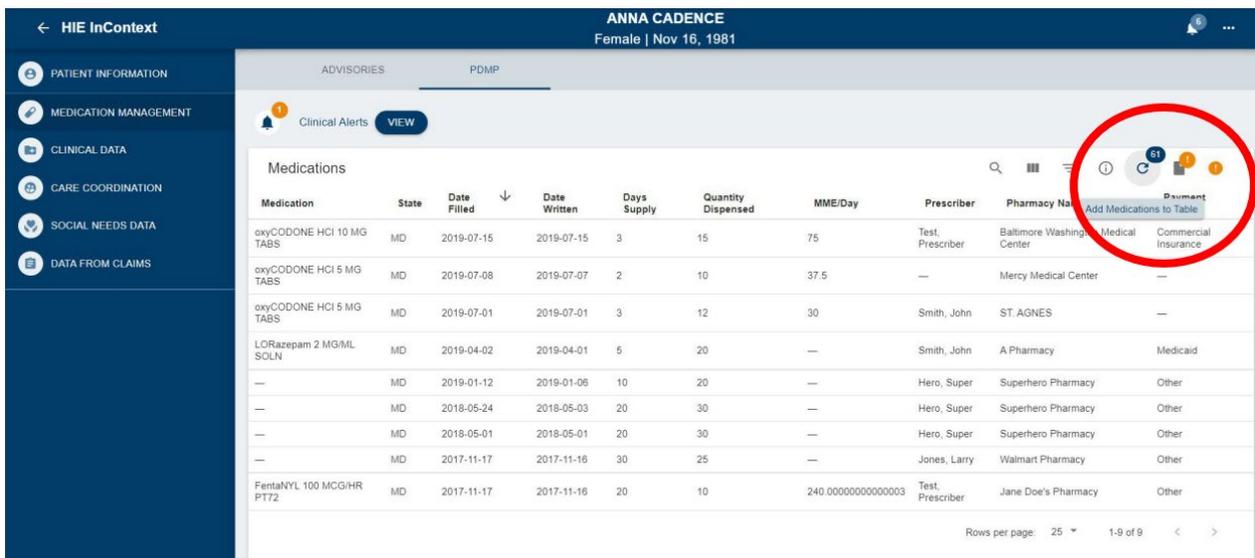
