This document covers the Value-Based Care Insights application only. The MedInsight system components and all other tools are released under separate release bulletins on separate schedules.

Overview

We are excited to announce the release of VBCI **V1.4.0**, our latest version of the Value-Based Care Insights application. With this release, we are adding three new dashboards in the application, an update to Post Acute Care benchmarks, and State of Maryland. Benchmarks at the DRG-level. Value-Based Care Insights (VBC Insights) is MedInsight's prescriptive reporting application, surfacing key cost-saving opportunities to drive VBC initiatives and delivering strategic data for key stakeholders to make data-driven decisions.

Prerequisites

- **Lakehouse 2024.3** – This new release is tied to 2024.3 Lakehouse release and client data will need to be run through this Lakehouse release for VBCI to work as intended.
- **Lakehouse 2025.1** – v1.4.0 release will also be in 2025.1 Lakehouse release. The 2025.1 Lakehouse release is *only* compatible with v1.4 and won't work on the VBCI v1.3 release (released in January 2025).

General Enhancements

New Features

- New Pages:
 - Provider Performance
 - Beneficiary Details
 - Inpatient Rehab
- Added State of Md. Benchmarks, sliced at the DRG level

Enhancements

- Split Facility ID columns in the Home Health dashboard
- Added a warning to the Global Filters UI when the selected time-period overlaps with claims runout
- Added Cost Opportunity columns to the Hospitals table in the Post-Acute Care (PAC) dashboard
- Limited trend charts in service category pages to show four years of data maximum
- Added a DRG Code column to the Beneficiary details tables in the IP Medical and Surgical pages
- Updated PAC benchmarks
- Enhanced DRG and DRG Families sorting so that a selected DRG always sorts to the top of the table

Bug Fixes

- Unknown providers are now sorted to the bottom of the provider tables
- Fixed sorting on Executive Summary Cost Savings Opportunity Table
- Fixed an issue causing previously sorted tables to re-order when a selection was made
