Updates

508 Compliance - Phase 2: Tab and SubTab Keyboard/Focus Management; PatientList Keyboard/Focus Management Tabbing | Phase 2 of the 508 Compliance update includes improved navigation with keyboard and focus order and ensures the entire application meets accessibility standards, particularly on patient matching pages.

Advanced Directives - Update My Directives Date | The My Directives table is updated, allowing users to view the Effective Date of the Directives alongside Date received. This change enables users to find the Effective Date easily, rather than reading through the description.

Encounters - Add OBS to Hospital Encounters | The Hospital Encounters section now displays more comprehensive hospital encounter data, including ADTs related to observations (OBS).

IronPdf Upgrade to Version 2024.12.9 | The PDF generation tool was updated to the latest version for better performance and reliability.

Federator Grpc Client - Send Gender Information | Gender information is now sent correctly in patient data exchanges. Patient gender will display in the demographics subtab.



Bug Fixes

Incorrect Numerical Sorting for Columns | Fixed the issue where numbers in tables were sorted incorrectly.

Saml Metadata Endpoint Reference Issue | Corrected the security certificate reference for better system integrity.

Pagination for Referral History Journal Entries | Fixed pagination to ensure all data is visible and accessible.

Updates

My Patient Summary | My Patient Summary is an editable dashboard that focuses on giving the user control from start to finish - it's a space built for their needs and their needs only. This feature enables a customizable tab model designed to save users time locating specific patient data within InContext.

This update comes after beta testing, that has altered several user experiences that include:

- 1. Users can drag and drop tables within My Patient Summary per their preferred order.
- 2. Pop-up windows will not take up the whole screen, so users can compare across pinned subtabs.
- 3. Add universal controls to "Hide my Organization" and "Filter and Search"
- 4. Snap to fit pinned tables
- 5. Users can hover over the pin icon to see the language "Pin X to My Patient Summary
