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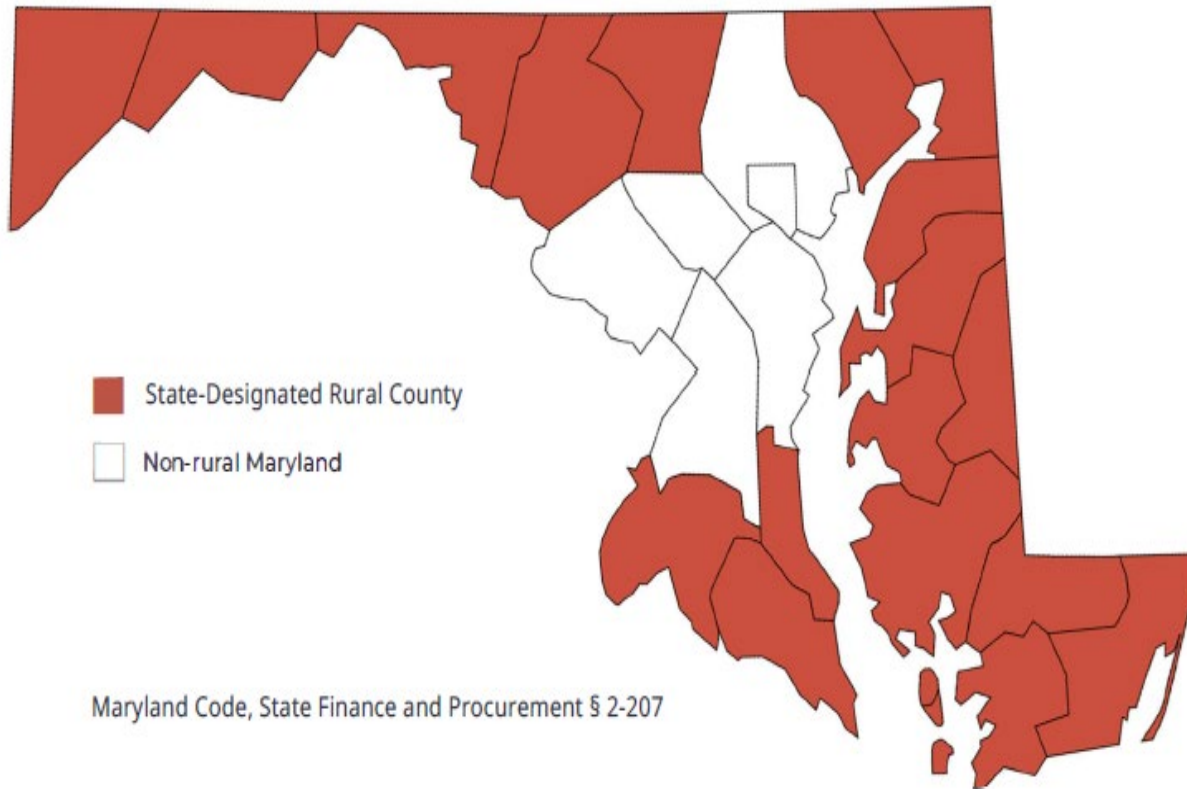
# • Program Overview



- In an effort to increase HIE adoption across Rural Maryland, CRISP is establishing the Rural Provider Connectivity and Optimization Program.
- This program offers funding to help offset the cost burden when building EHR interfaces to exchange data via CRISP.
- This work is part of the Maryland [Rural Health Transformation Program \(RHTP\)](#), which, in part, seeks to strengthen healthcare delivery in rural areas through innovative technologies and partnerships.



# • Who Qualifies?



- HIPAA covered providers located in rural Maryland or with a majority of patients from rural Maryland may be eligible for funding under this program.
- Rural Maryland is defined under Maryland Law:
  - Allegany, Garrett, Washington, Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, Worcester, Calvert, Charles, St. Mary's, Carroll, Frederick, and Harford Counties
