




- CEND - **CSS Event Notification Delivery**

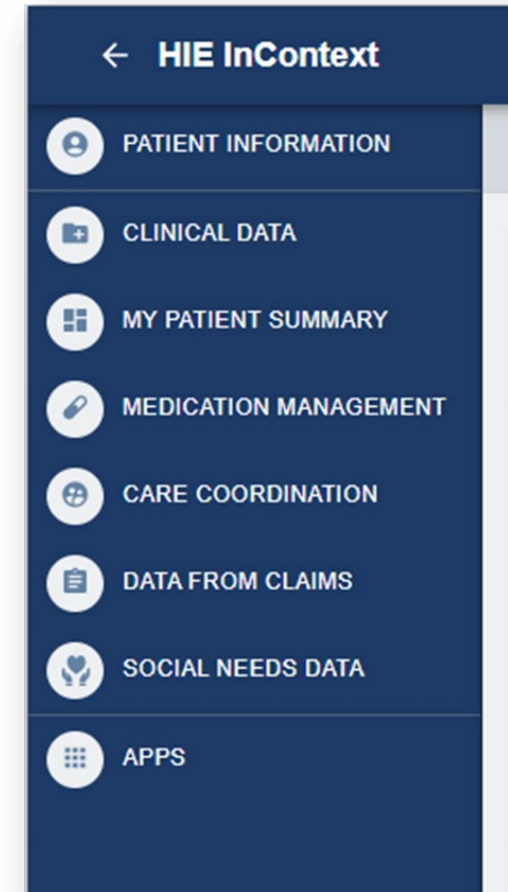



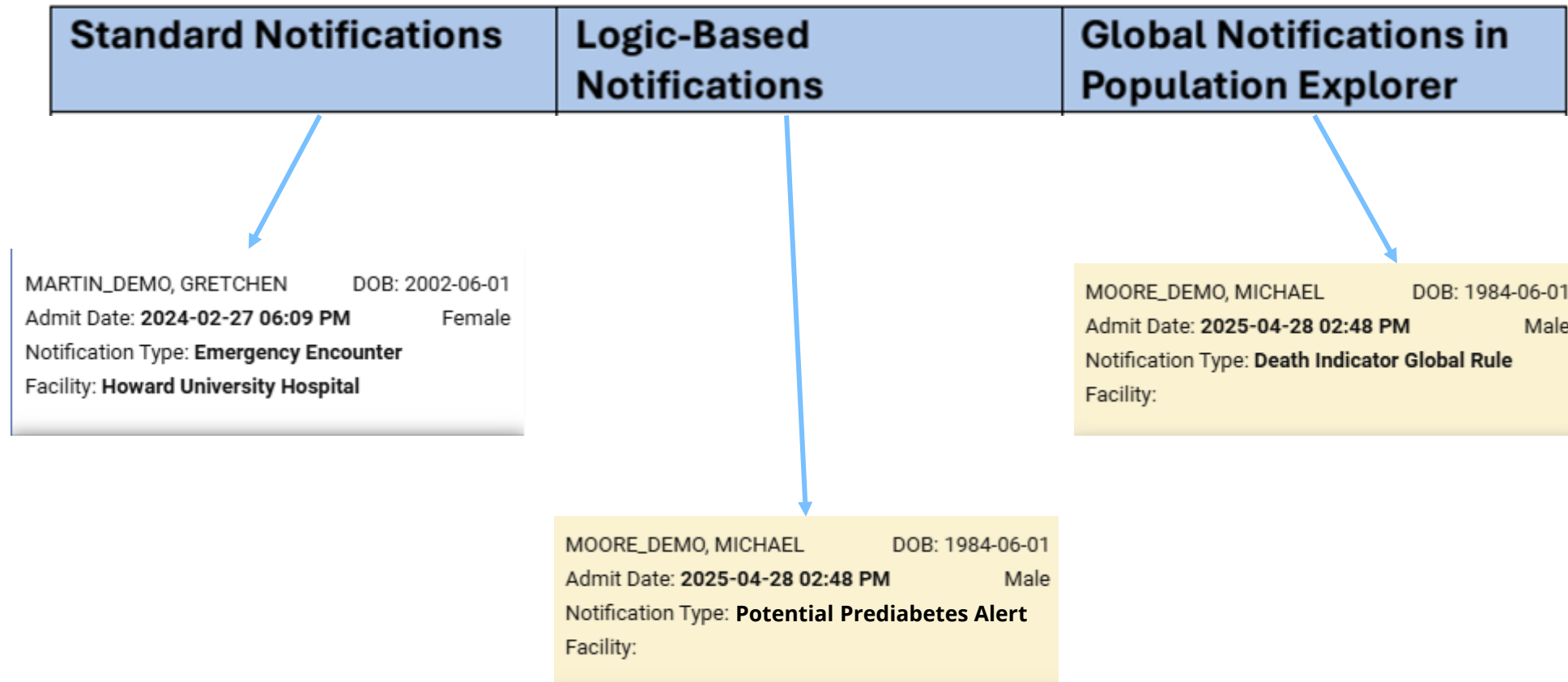

New Features in CRISP Care Coordination Tools

Notification Types





Logic-Based Alerts

Criteria-based notifications to close care gaps and enhance proactive patient care

WHAT ARE LOGIC-BASED ALERTS (a.k.a. Intelligent Alerts) ?

Logic-based alerts in Population Explorer use selective criteria to flag patients. For providers and care managers, this means earlier identification of at-risk patients, timely intervention to help prevent avoidable readmissions, and better alignment of resources through improved continuity of care so teams can prioritize high-risk individuals with actionable insights.



Behavioral Health Alerts

- Mental Health Follow-up - Notifications for patients who have received a diagnosis of a mental illness or have engaged in self-harm, as well as those who have participated in a mental health follow-up service.
- Non Fatal Overdose Alert EMS Rule - Notifications for overdose alerts treated by EMS.
- Non Fatal Overdose Alert Hospital Rule - Notifications for overdose alerts treated by a hospital.



Chronic Conditions Alerts

- Timely Follow Up Chronic Conditions - Notifications for patients with that have ICD10 codes related to chronic conditions, and symptoms/signs of abnormal clinical and laboratory findings in their visit.
- Chronic Kidney Disease - Notification to inform clinicians or the care team when their patient has a visit(s) related to kidney disease.
- ESRD Incoming Diagnosis Code - Notification for patients across many of the specific diagnosis codes of kidney failure.
- Potential Prediabetes (type 1 or 2) Alert Rule - Notifications for patients with elevated HbA1c



Maternal Health Alerts

- Complication of Pregnancy - Notification for encounters for patients with complications associated with pregnancy.
- Labor and Delivery - Notifications for patients going through labor and delivery.
- High Risk Pregnancy - Notifications triggered based on pregnancy diagnosis codes, with consideration of the patient's age.
- Pregnancy Incoming Diagnosis Rule - Notifications for pregnancy visits related to DG codes for pregnancy, condition aggravated by pregnancy, occurred during childbirth or the postpartum period.
- Prenatal Lab Alert - Notification for prenatal labs.



Logic-Based Alerts

Criteria-based notifications to close care gaps and enhance proactive patient care



Preventative Services Alerts

- Breast Cancer Screening - Notifications for patients that have had a screening for breast cancer
- Colorectal Cancer Screening - Notifications for patients that had a colonoscopy event



Utilization Alerts

- High Utilizer Notification Rule - Notifications for patients who have more than 2 prior emergency, admit, discharge or registration events in the last 180 days.
- Observation Status Alert Rule - Notifications for observation visits.
- Readmission Emergency Rule - Notifications for patients who have been readmitted to a facility in the last 30 days with at least one emergency discharge.
- Readmission Inpatient Rule - Notifications for patients who have been readmitted to a facility in the last 30 days with at least one emergency inpatient.



Other Logic-Based Alerts

- Death Indicator - Notification to inform clinician or the care team when their patient has deceased/expired
- Low Acuity Non-Emergent (LANE) Incoming Diagnosis Rule - Encounters for patients with low acuity non-emergent needs (LANE).
- Conditions of Participation: Alternative Events System (CARES) - Notifications to inform a Primary Care Provider of patient encounters when the provider does not have an existing attributed panel relationship with the patient.
