Pre-Requisite Requirements - Basic On-Boarding requirements: - Provider has fully executed Participation Agreement (PA), Notice of Privacy Practices (NPP), Substance Abuse Attestation (SUD) with CRISP. - Provider has fully executed a Lab Corp and Quest data release form, or other lab feed agreement. - Provider has completed a CRISP HIE Administrator and provider training. - Provider has completed W-9 - Provider submits a new patient panel every 90 days, or sooner. - Executed Memorandum of Understanding Technical limitations may be discovered during the completion of prerequisite requirements, preventing participants from fully satisfying the Milestone 1-3 requirements. In such cases, participants will retain Prerequisite Requirement payment.	Prerequisite Attestation MOU	\$2,000
M1: Practice's EHR establishes ADT feed with CRISP Establish ADTs feed directly from the practice's EHR CRISP ADT (Admission, Discharge, Transfer): The ADT interface enables real-time sharing of admission, discharge, and transfer events across Maryland's healthcare settings. This workflow supports care coordination, reduces readmissions, and improves visibility for providers, care managers, and other stakeholders. Eligible practices: any organization without existing ADT connections with CRISP.	Attestation A	\$7,500
M2: Practice's EHR establishes CCD feed with CRISP Establish encounter and clinical data feeds directly from the practice's EHR. CRISP CCD (Continuity of Care Document): The CCD interface enables the exchange of standardized clinical care documents for patients across Maryland's healthcare settings. The CCD is a structured document that contains essential information for care transitions, chronic disease management, and longitudinal records. Eligible practices: any organization without existing CCD connections with CRISP.	Attestation B	\$7,500

M3: Establish InContext Outbound Connection with CRISP Complete the CRISP InContext interface workflow, which enables clinicians to access CRISP's patient data — such as lab results, encounter history, imaging reports, CCDs, alerts, and care coordination information — directly from within their own EHR. Eligible practices: any organization without an existing CRISP InContext interface.	Attestation C	\$8,000
All practices will receive \$500 for each eligible FTE provider (MD, PA, NP, DO) per practice upon completion of the clinical data interface. This will be included in the final payment.	Attestation D	\$500/FTE Provider (up to \$15,000)
Maximum Potential Payment per Organization		\$40,000
